About CAPE

Community Activities Project Ealing (CAPE) was founded 20 years ago, to meet the needs of individuals living with mental health needs in the local community. Our founding service was a safe place in the form of a Café where people could meet and take up peer support. This service continues to this day. However, over the years we have recognised that we are working with a wide range of needs that have an impact on an individual's mental health and wellbeing, so we have developed and continue to develop a suite of services, voluntary and training positions to respond to a wide range of needs. We focus on the individual not just the diagnosis, which encourages us to recognise that each person is different and has complex needs and so our response needs to be multi-layered.

Role outline and the difference you will make

We are looking for a passionate and dedicated people to join the team in our busy charity shop in Acton West London. CAPE Charity Shop currently operates 6 days a week, although we are exploring opening on a Sunday.

You will learn alongside the professional staff, and volunteers learning essential retail skills. Our shop volunteers are the first point of contact for customers when they enter our shop. You will be a welcome greeting for all customers helping and ultimately helping increase donations.

We can support skills training and confidence in the following: -

- Customer service, till and cash handling
- Merchandising and window displays
- IT assistance
- Shop promotions and events
- Processing stock, including new goods, donated clothing and bric-a-brac.
- Experience working in a busy environment
- Leadership skills
- Experience in communicating with people from diverse backgrounds and needs.
- lunch expenses reimbursed where appropriate.
- Monthly supervision by a professional

Core tasks and what you will achieve

- Greet customers with a warm welcome when they come into the shop, and offer to assist them
- Serve customers in the shop using the till, taking money, and wrapping goods
- Help and advise customers when needed
- Ensure that the shop is clean and tidy always, and that goods are displayed neatly
- Sort and price clothes, books, and any other goods that you are trained to do
- Sort through donations that are brought into the shop

- Check stocks of CAPE's goods and accessories, and replenish when necessary
 - Assist with window displays which promote the goods in the shop, as well as CAPE events
 - Accept donations, and promote Gift Aid to those that have brought them in
 - Undertake training as required by the CAPE Shops Ltd
 - Steam any clothing donations to make them presentable to sell
 - Changing old stock for new
